Harriet Mulenga comes from Zambia where she works with CHAMP Zambia as Psychosocial Counsellor. She tested positive for HIV soon after her husband, a minibus driver, died of TB. When she was no longer able to care for herself, she moved in with her mother but found a chilly reception.

In a documentary film, Esther Chikondo Harriet's mother speaks honestly about her struggle to accept her daughter after she was diagnosed HIVpositive. Esther says she used to let Harriet eat outside, and that she asked herself, "If I touch her, will I get HIV?" She also says she told her daughter she was bringing shame to the family: "Just die! Who cares about you?"

All members of the public are invited to come and see the film and have to discuss with Harriet.
